

Creative Clicks Camp Description

The Digital Darkroom - Every Photo Tells a Story.

Campers must provide the following prior to coming to camp

- Registration form
- Payment in full

Campers will need to bring the following every day:

- A digital SLR or other digital camera that is capable of shooting in Manual mode. It is not necessary that a camper have an SLR (you can switch lenses) camera. ** I have 2 cameras to loan to campers that do not have cameras.
- A memory card for the camera that is at least 4 GB (or several memory cards) please write your child's name on it.
- A backpack
- Water
- Snack
- Lunch (that they can take with them on field trips)
- small umbrella
- sunblock
- comfortable shoes for walking

Campers will need the following on the first day

- Memory card (s) or disk containing their Day in the Life Images. - Prior to coming to Camp the camper should document a day in their life (wake up to bed time) using their digital cameras. Campers should use the skills gained through Digital Photography Fun! (or other) to create images that tell the story of a typical day in their lives. There is no limit on the amount of images, as culling through images is part of the decision making process in any photo journalists' story.

Campers should be dropped off between 8:45 and 9 am and picked up no later than 3:00 pm.

Sample Day

9-12 – Topic introduction, and practice. (computer or fieldwork)

12-1:30 – lunch and free time, work on portfolios

1:30-3 - introduction of new topic for following day /practice and games.

Monday and Friday will be non-fieldwork days. Monday will be an introduction day and Friday will be spent on completing their final project. Campers will have a small art reception to show off their work.
